- Request by Sheri Laratonda for addition of one-time line item in the amount of \$400 for cotton candy to sell in Spirit Wear store. Motion to approve by Lauren Monaco and second by Sheri Laratonda. None opposed. The motion was approved.
- Q: Request by Erin Rivera to increase Bee Club line item by \$2,000 for this year to cover cost of program expansion. The cost to outfit new junior beekeepers with suits and gloves is about \$600. Additionally, the Bee Club has plans with the help of Mt. Cuba Center and Delaware Nature Society to complete a native plant pollinator garden in the field near the Outdoor Classroom. This will include a seating area as well. This will not cover the full estimated cost

of \$6,000. Funds are also being sought from grants and donors. Successes of the bee club include production of honey, candles, and lip balm. NSE honey is being sold in Gateway Garden Center in Hockessin. The benefit to students is they are learning beekeeping, advertising, product production, pricing, and business. Students are also provided many educational experiences including visits from entomologists and naturalists. The Bee Club plans to maintain the garden during meetings when they are not at the hives, every other week, although once established it should not require much maintenance.

- Motion by Erin Rivera to increase Bee Club line item by \$2,000 and second by Bonnie Principe. None in opposition. The motion is approved.
- Vote to approve the full 2023/2024 PTA Budget. 19 in favor, none opposed. The budget was approved.
